The “E” indicates serving as an EM (either Cup or Host). The “D” serves only if there is not a deacon. The D gets the consecrated Hosts from the Tabernacle and distributes the Cup and Host to the EMs. The D serves at the center break.

The D returns the undistributed Hosts to the Tabernacle.

When facing the altar, the first two EMs on the right go to the choir to distribute Communion. The next two go to the break on the choir side.

The EMs on the far left of the altar go to the back on the Baptismal side and the next two EMs serve in the front.

Roberta Dola and I will be doing the schedule for the summer. If you are unable to serve, please call either one of us. Roberta and I are not scheduled and are available to fill in as needed.

Please dress to serve at Mass even if you are not scheduled. No jeans, shorts or sneakers.
